### **Pablo Iglesias Prada**

Pablo Iglesias Prada (Ciañu, 1974) is a visual artist who lives and works in Gijón, Spain. He studied Design and Illustration in the School of Arts in Oviedo and then carried out post-graduate studies in audiovisual creation, cinematographic practice, lithography and engraving and holds a master's degree in Motion Graphics Creation, Direction, Management and Production.

Pablo mainly works with drawing and painting but has interests in disciplines such as comic illustration, video and photography. He has exhibited his work widely in Spain in Asturias, Barcelona and Madrid and internationally in Hong Kong, London, Miami, Brussels, Istanbul and Geneva.

The prizes awarded to Pablo include the Art-Nalón 2004 award, the Cajastur Scholarship for artists 2011, the Asturias Joven 2005 prize for visual arts, the IV Al-Norte Scholarship and the Gijón City Council grant for artistic productions in 2008 and 2014.

Pablo has collaborated with musicians and DJs including the creation of the Artwork "Titan" was for the highly regarded DJ Oscar Mulero, "The Sleeper" with the artist S/H/U/Y/A, "The Gaping Mouth" with the band Lowertown and various collaborations with the Italian label DUB Musik Limited.

Other artistic collaborations include his work with fashion designer Walter Van Beirendonck where Pablo designed the invitation for "MIRROR", the ss2021 collection Walter Van Beirendonck presented at Paris Fashion Week. This design became part of the designer's collection with the production of a limited edition of T-shirts. Recently one of Pablo's paintings was chosen as the skateboard design for skateboarding legend Jamie Thomas for ZERO SKATEBOARDS.
